FOLLOW-UP NUMBER 28 TOCOORDINATED VIETNAMESE COMMUNISTOFFENSIVE EVIDENCED IN SOUTH VIETNAM (252332Z JAN)

SIGINT available through 5 February continues to reveal a concentration of unidentified Vietnamese Communist radio stations to the south of Saigon. On 4 and 5 February at least five and possibly as many as nine terminals were located within an area 5 km to the south of the Cholon District of Saigon. The tentative Long An Provincial Unit was also located in this area at 10-42N 106-39E (XS 804834) on 4 February. The high number of unidentified stations in this area has been evident since the beginning of February.¹

Immediately to the north of Saigon there are at least three unidentified stations located in the area of 10-51N 106-40E (XT 8100) as of 5 February. One of these unidentified stations was located near the northern perimeter of Tan Son Nhut at 10-51N 106-40E (XS 814986) on 1 February,² and has redeployed to 10-52N 106-40E (XT 822029) by 5 February.² This element and another entity located on 4 February at 10-52N 106-39E (XT 802014) have been noted in communications with an unidentified control authority located on 4 February near the Michelin Plantation on the Binh Duong-Hau Nghia Province border at 11-12N 106-27E (XT 599378). This element also communicates with at least two other unidentified elements.
